

At their June 2011 meeting, the Distribution Committee of The Troy Foundation reviewed eleven grant applications and awarded a total of \$65,029.75 in grants. Grants were awarded to the following:

- Troy City Schools - \$3,600.00 in support of the Kids to College Program at Van Cleve School
- Bradford Ohio Railroad Museum - \$7,500.00 to purchase a multi-media system as part of the museum renovation
- Troy REC - \$2,000.00 in support of the Summer Lunch Buddies Program
- St. Patrick Catholic Church - \$1,004.00 in support of the Single and Parenting Support Program
- Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra - \$19,960.00 in support of the Orchestra Discoveries Program for Troy Schools
- Troy City Schools - \$9,100.00 in support of TroyOhio Reads at Kyle School
- School of Urban Studies - \$5,000.00 in support of the Young Men of Valor Program
- Dream Builders Group/The Clubhouse - \$2,000.00 for summer teen internships
- Dayton Children's Medical Center - \$10,000.00 in support of the Soin Pediatric Trauma and Emergency Care Center renovation and expansion
- Miami County Children's Services - \$3,000.00 in support of the Schools Supply Drive
- Troy Soccer Parents Association – \$1,865.75 for the purchase of soccer uniforms

All grants were awarded from the Troy Foundation General Fund.

The Troy Foundation was established in 1924 by Augustus Stouder with the purpose of creating a better life and building a better future for those in Troy and the surrounding community. In the last year, the Foundation has awarded over \$4.1 million dollars in grants to assist with a wide variety of services and programs to benefit our community. The Distribution Committee meets quarterly to review grant applications. The next meeting is scheduled for September 15, 2011. The deadline for submitting grants to be reviewed at that meeting is August 15. Only charitable 501 (c) 3 organizations may apply.
