

## Growing a Greater Tomorrow Fund Guidelines for Donations

Donations will NOT be accepted until 8:00 am on Tuesday, December 3<sup>rd</sup> at Hobart Arena and must be made in person.

Please follow the guidelines listed below when considering making a matching gift through The Troy Foundation's Growing a Greater Tomorrow Fund:

- Only gifts to tax deductible charitable organizations in good standing that serve the residents of Troy will be matched.
- Programs operated by a church that serve the residents of Troy AND are non-denominational in nature, may also qualify to be matched (Backpack Program, First Place Food Pantry, Richards Chapel Lunch program, etc.).
- Schools are not eligible to be matched through this program, but have an opportunity to apply for Apple Grants each spring.
- A maximum of \$250 to each individual organization per donor.
- \$2,500 is the maximum amount matched per household (only \$250 may be given to an individual organization).
- Each organization may be matched only up to \$10,000.
- Donations will be matched on a first come, first served basis until the funds are depleted.
- Online donations will not be matched.
- Organizations cannot make gifts to be matched from themselves or other organizations.
- Advisors of Charitable Checking Funds and Donor Advised Funds may have donations matched from their funds ONLY if the request is received by stopping by to complete a distribution form.
- All donations must be made in person during the Growing A Greater Tomorrow event.
  Donors unable to make a donation in person may make their donation using a personal representative. Please call the Foundation to make arrangements to do so.
- Gifts of cash cannot be accepted.
